Chatting Time

Talk with your child/ren about what are safe animals and what are dangerous animals, the difference between tame and wild. Ask your child/ren if they have ever stroked an elephant, lion, monkey, cat, dog or rabbit. Are they safe animals? Are they wild and dangerous?

Question Time
